**The Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) Regulations,
2003.**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the President by section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges Act, 1965, these Regulations are made this 22nd day of August, 2003.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) Regulations, 2003.

2. Extension of Immunities and Privileges

The immunities and privileges conferred on diplomatic agents by virtue of the Act are hereby extended to the organisations prescribed in the Schedule to these Regulations and to the representatives, officials and employees of the said organisations who are not citizens of Uganda or persons permanently or ordinarily resident in Uganda.
