The External Trade (Importation Licence) (No. 2) Order, 2001. (Made under section 5A of the External Trade Act, Cap. 103)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5A of the External Trade Act, this Order is made this 10th day of April, 2001.

1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the External Trade (Importation Licence) (No. 2) Order, 2001.

2. Grant of exclusive licence

(1) The persons listed in column 1 of the Schedule are granted exclusive licences to import used tyres of different sizes, in the quantities listed in column 2 of the Schedule.

(2) The exclusive licences referred to in sub-paragraph (1) shall be valid for the one year only and if the licence expires before a person has imported the number of used tyres authorised by the licence, that person shall forfeit the balance of the tyres not imported.
