The Stamps (Exemption from Stamp Duty) (Transfer of Properties to the Sisters of the Holy Cross Association Ltd and Mortgage on Property by Tororo Cement Industries Ltd) (No. 1) Instrument, 2001.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister responsible for finance by section 10 of the Stamps Act, this Instrument is made this 7th day of November, 2000.

1. Citation.

This Instrument may be cited as the Stamps (Exemption from Stamp Duty) (Transfer of Properties to the Sisters of the Holy Cross Association Ltd and Mortgage on Property by Tororo Cement Industries Ltd) (No. 1) Instrument, 2001.

2. Remission of stamp duty.
