**The Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Exemption) (No. 4)
Order, 2000.**

(Under section 176 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for works, housing and communications by section 176 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, this Order is made this 24th day of August, 2000.

1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Exemption) (No. 4) Order, 2000.

2. Exemption

A person who drives a motor vehicle and who competes in the two days national rally competition organised by the Motorsport Africa Club and described as the "Total Pearl of Africa Rally" commencing on the 2nd September, 2000 and ending on the 3rd September, 2000 is exempted from the provisions of subsections (1) and (2) of section 121 of the Act for the duration of that rally.
