THE SUPPLIES ORDINANCE, 1914.

DIRECTIONS.

Issued by the Supplies Board under the above-mentioned Ordinance.

1. (1) IN THE TOWNSHIPS of Entebbe, Kampala and Jinja no person shall sell any of the articles mentioned in the Schedule hereto at a price above the maximum price fixed for such article in the said Schedule; and

Elsewhere in the Protectorate no person shall sell any of the articles so mentioned at a price above such maximum price plus the actual cost of transport from Entebbe, Kampala or Jinja as the case may be.

In calculating the actual cost of transport all expenses incidental to such transport may be included.

- (2) This Direction shall only apply to articles sold for cash, and shall not apply to articles sold on credit.

2. Any person failing to comply with these Directions will be guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding one year or to fine or to both, and any supplies in respect of which an offence has been committed will be liable to confiscation.
