THE SUPPLIES ORDINANCE, 1914.

DIRECTIONS

*Issued by the Supplies Board under the above-mentioned Ordinance.*

1. THE DIRECTIONS under the above-mentioned Ordinance, dated the 13th August, 1917, are hereby cancelled, and the following Schedule is hereby substituted for the Schedule to the Directions under the said Ordinance dated the 7th August, 1917, and published in a *Gazette Extraordinary* of the 8th August, 1917, viz. :—

2. The attention of Uganda Merchants is drawn to the Regulations issued under Martial law in the East Africa Protectorate *Official Gazette* of the 15th August, 1917, by which certain powers are given to a Food Controller to be appointed. Merchants importing direct to Uganda and not buying in Mombasa should notify the Food Controller in advance of the arrival of their shipments, so as to avoid delay in the issue of his permit for booking the supplies through to Uganda.
