## An Ordinance relating to Medical Registration.

[10TH MAY, 1917.]

Enacted by the Governor of the Uganda Protectorate.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Medical Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, 1917," and shall be read as one with the Medical Registration Ordinance, 1913, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance.)

Short title and construction.

2. Section fifteen of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor, *viz.* :—

Section 15 of Ordinance No. 9 of 1913 repealed.

"XV. Every Medical Practitioner in the public service of the Protectorate or of the East Africa Protectorate shall be entitled to be registered free of charge, but such registration shall be cancelled upon such Medical Practitioner leaving such public service."

" Medical Officers to be registered " free."

provided always that the registration of any Medical Officer effected under section fifteen of the principal Ordinance prior to the commencement of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, but only so long as such Medical Officer remains in the service of the Protectorate or of the East Africa Protectorate.

3. The Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the heading "Name and Place of Original Registration" and substituting therefor the following, *viz.* :— "Date and Place of Original Registration."

## An Ordinance to repeal the Entebbe Port Ordinance, 1905.

[15TH MAY, 1917.]

Enacted by the Governor of the Uganda Protectorate.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Entebbe Port (Repeal) Ordinance, 1917."

Short title.

2. The Entebbe Port Ordinance, 1905, is hereby repealed but without prejudice to anything lawfully done thereunder or to the prosecution of any offence committed before the commencement of this Ordinance.

### PROCLAMATION.

I, HENRY RICHARD WALLIS, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor of the Uganda Protectorate, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Uganda Order in Council, 1902, Article 6 (1) with the approval of the Secretary of State for the Colonies do hereby declare as follows:—

1. That part of the County of Busuju in Buganda bounded on the West by the River Katabalanga, on the North by the present boundary between the Counties of Bwekula and Busuju and on the East and South by the River Nabakasi is hereby transferred to and shall henceforth form part of the County of Bwekula in Buganda.

2. That part of the County of Busuju in Buganda bounded on the North West by the River Nabakasi, on the North East by the present boundary between the Counties of Singo and Busuju, on the South East by the River Kibimba and on the South and South West by the present boundary between the Counties of Busuju and Gomba is hereby transferred to and shall henceforth form part of the County of Gomba in Buganda.

\*NOTE (3).—Trading is prohibited under the Trading with the Enemy Proclamations of 25th June and 10th November, 1915, with any person or firm of enemy nationality resident or carrying on business in China, Siam, Persia, Morocco, Liberia or Portuguese East Africa. Persons or firms in the United Kingdom are therefore prohibited from trading with any person or firm of enemy nationality in any of those countries, even though such person or firm is not mentioned by name in the Statutory List.

NOTE (4).—In order to minimise as far as possible any inconvenience which may be caused to British traders by the dislocation of export trade owing to the inclusion in the Statutory List of a former connection, the Foreign Trade Department is collecting and classifying the names of non-enemy firms who may be able to act as substitutes for firms mentioned in the Statutory List. A considerable amount of information is already available at the Foreign Trade Department, and it is in many cases possible to suggest the names of satisfactory substitutes without the necessity of referring the matter abroad. The Department is however, prepared, on application, to enquire of His

Majesty's Representatives abroad for the names of suitable substitutes. When the applicant wishes this done by telegraph he is required to undertake to pay the cost of telegraphic correspondence. It would greatly facilitate the work of the Foreign Trade Department if applicants, in making enquiries, would specify the particular trade or trades for which substitutes are required.

NOTE (5).—The Statutory List for each country is telegraphed, on the day of issue, to His Majesty's Representative in that country, who is instructed to notify accordingly British Consular Officers, to whom persons abroad should apply for information as to names on the List. Persons and firms in the United Kingdom with agencies or branches abroad would, however, be well advised to furnish such agencies or branches with issues of the List as they appear. The Lists for all countries in Central or South America are also telegraphed to His Majesty's Ambassador at Washington, who transmits them to His Majesty's Consul-General at New York and to other centres in the United States likely to be interested.
