THE MASTERS AND SERVANTS ORDINANCE, 1913.
RULES.

THE MASTERS AND SERVANTS RULES (EASTERN
PROVINCE), 1917.

1. THESE RULES may be cited as "The Masters and Servants Rules (Eastern Province), 1917.

2. No person shall recruit or enter into a contract to employ any native in the Eastern Province except upon condition that the native so recruited or engaged shall before commencing such employment be taken before the chief Administrative Officer of the district in which he resides and if such Officer is of opinion that the native is suitable for military service he may refuse to permit his employment by such person.

3. Any person failing to comply with these Rules shall be guilty of an offence punishable with imprisonment of either description which may extend to one month or a fine not exceeding 100 rupees or both.
