The Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Kahendero Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.

(Under sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996, Statute No. 14 of 1996).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for wildlife by sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996; and after consultation with the local government council of Kasese District; and with the approval of Parliament signified by its resolution passed on 27th may 2002, this Instrument is made this 3rd day of April, 2003.

1. Citation

This Instrument may be cited as the Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Kahendero Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.

2. Declaration of Kahendero Wildlife Sanctuary as wildlife conservation area

The area of land specified in the Schedule to this Instrument is declared a wildlife conservation area to be known as Kahendero Wildlife Sanctuary.

3. Area to be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area

The area declared under paragraph 2 shall be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area for the purposes of section 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996.

SCHEDULE

Boundaries of Kahendero Wildlife Sanctuary

Commencing at beacon KHR1 on the shore of Lake George, thence in a north-westerly direction on bearing 297.8° for a distance of 127.6 metres approximately to pillar KHR2; thence on a bearing of 337.4° for a distance of 600.8 metres approximately to pillar KHR3; thence on a bearing of 335 for a distance of 329 metres approximately to pillar KHR4; thence on a bearing of 6° for a distance of 365.4° approximately to pillar KHR5; thence on a bearing of 6.1° for a distance of 182.3 metres approximately to pillar KHR6; thence on a bearing of 2.4° for a distance of 342.6 metres approximately to pillar KHR7; thence on a bearing of 119.2° for a distance of 366.7 metres approximately to pillar KHR8; thence on a bearing 119.6° for a distance of 181.4 metres approximately to pillar KHR9; thence on a bearing of 119.4°

for a distance of 189.7 metres approximately to pillar KHR10 on the shore of Lake George; thence southwards along the shore of Lake George to the point of commencement.

This boundary is more particularly shown on Boundary Plan UG/WILDLIFE/QENP/01 deposited at the Survey Records Office in the Department Responsible for Surveys and Mapping.
