The Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Kayanja Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.

(Under sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996, Statute No. 14 of 1996).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for wildlife by sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996; and after consultation with the local government council of Kasese District; and with the approval of Parliament signified by its resolution passed on 27th May 2003, this Instrument is made this 3rd day of April, 2003.

1. Citation

This Instrument may be cited as the Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Kayanja Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.

2. Declaration of Kayanja Wildlife Sanctuary as wildlife conservation area

The area of land specified in the Schedule to this Instrument is declared a wildlife conservation area to be known as Kayanja Wildlife Sanctuary.

3. Area to be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area

The area declared under paragraph 2 shall be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area for the purposes of section 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996.

SCHEDULE

Boundaries of Kayanja Wildlife Sanctuary

Commencing at beacon KJA1 on the shore of Lake Edward, thence in a easterly direction on a bearing of 95.4° for a distance of 201.2 metres approximately to pillar KJA2; thence on a bearing of 5.1° for a distance of 154.3 metres approximately to pillar KJA3; thence on a bearing of 7.2° for a distance of 127.1 metres approximately to pillar KJA4; thence on a bearing of 11° for a distance of 112.7 metres approximately to pillar KJA5; thence on a bearing of 22.1° for a distance of 186.1 metres approximately to pillar KJA6; thence on a bearing of 1.4° for a distance of 137.4 metres approximately to pillar KJA7; thence on a bearing of 16° for a distance of 142.9 metres approximately to pillar KJA8; thence on a bearing 277.5° for a distance of 107.7 metres approximately to pillar KJA9; thence on a bearing of 274.2° for a distance of 219.3 metres approximately to pillar KJA10; thence on a bearing 182.1° for a distance of

106 metres approximately to pillar KJA11; thence on a bearing of 246.9° for a distance of 86 metres to pillar KJA12 on the shore of Lake Edward; thence southwards along the shore of Lake Edward to the point of commencement.

This boundary is more particularly shown on Boundary Plan UG/WILDLIFE/QENP/01 deposited at the Survey Records Office in the Department Responsible for Surveys and Mapping.
